Appropriations and Authorization

- Congress Currently working under a Continuing Resolution for FY 2017 through December 8th
 - Congress Currently working under a Continuing Resolution for FY 2017 through December 8th
 - Another CR through Dec. 22 is likely
- Submitted 25 Request for Funding (FY18) to the House and Senate
 - Requested that 30% of the ER budget be dedicated to MMRP for FY18 Budget
 - Letter signed by a total of 29 members signed the Defense Subcommittee House Committee on Appropriations as compared to 22 last year.
 - Rep. Crawford signed the letter. First Republican to sign our request.


Appropriations and Authorization

 - ER Navy \$323,649,000
 - +42.2 million for PFOA/PFOS Remediation
 - ER Air Force \$323,749,000
 - +30 million PFOA/PFOS Remediation
 - BRAC \$290,867,000
 - +35 million
 - ER FUDS \$208,673,000
 - ER DW \$9,002,000




ER Funding Trend

2018 UXO Caucus

UXO Caucus

Merge the efforts of the UXO Caucus with the EOD Caucus

- Rep Farr previous Chair for the UXO Caucus retired
- Blumenauer's office has not registered the UXO Caucus for the 115th Congress
 - They have not found a Republican to co-chair and Mr. Blumenauer does not want to start it unless he has a Republican.
- Rep. Crawford Chair of the EOD Caucus
- Challenge to get Republican support
- Efforts continue and progress being made to merge the efforts of two Caucus's
 - TLG met Rep Crawford at a fund raiser and brought it up. Rep. Crawford seems in support of merging the two caucuses and has stated that he supports registering the Caucus as the EOD/UXO Caucus.
- The EOD Caucus supported (in writing) NAOC's Issue to support FUDS Funding for clear-up

Low Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA)

LPTA

- Request from House Armed Services Committee (HASC) to provide a White Paper addressing LPTA concerns for MMRP
 - Letter provided to the HASC
- TLG spoke to the Defense Procurement Acquisition Policy (DPAP) office regarding the DFARS/LPTA issue.
 - NAOC provided input/comment regarding the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 as suggested

Guam

Guam

- NAOC Wrote a White Paper concerning Guam Munitions Response (MRS) Issues (2/17)
 - Provided to the House Armed Services Committee
 - White Paper provided some observations and recommendations from NAOC MRS Providers working on the Island of Guam
 - Recently the DoD reported to Congress
 - Reflected many of NAOC's points
 - Hoping hear more from NAVFAC HQTRS this week
